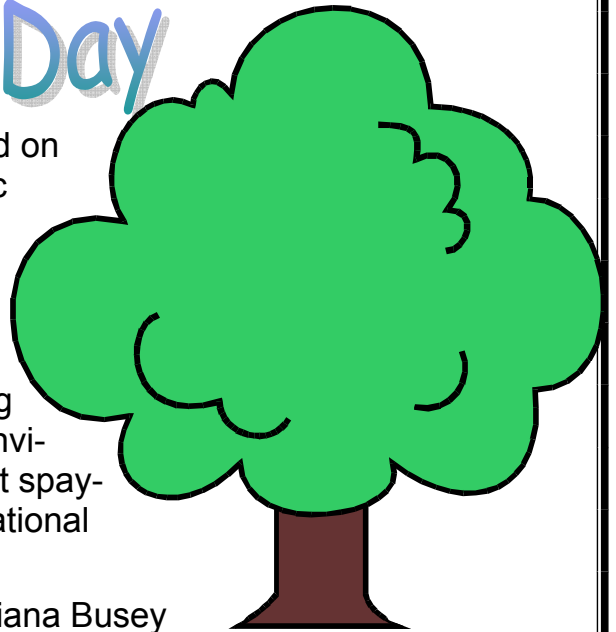


Earth Day-Every Day

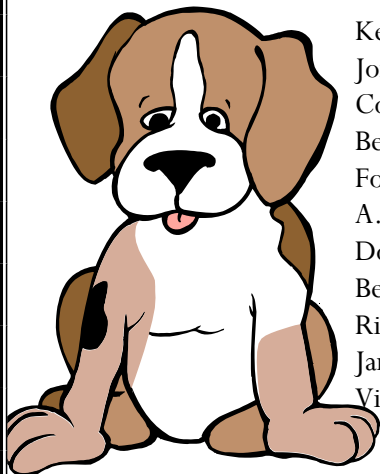

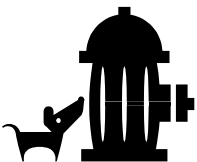
